A) Write out each 8 count of choreography using specific terms. Follow the structure below in writing your choreography:

8	step r (1) point l (2) cross l (3) point r (4) pas de bourree r (5&6) kick bc l (7&8)
8	Parts (1, 2, 3) drag to T, grab r arm up; hold count (4) ball change back (5-6) pivot
	front (7-8)

- B) Highlight your adjective phrases that you have used in your choreography. These are the phrases you created before you started the project. They should describe your theme using movement.
- C) Using a colored pen or pencil, write the way you have manipulated a phrase next to the 8 count where you have manipulated it.
