Music Charting Terminology

I. Purpose for charting music:

- 1. To organize your thoughts for choreography.
- 2. To find out how many 8 counts or 6 counts are in the music.
- 3. To fing the changes in the music.
- 4. To find out the sections of the music.
- 5. To cut the music down to fit the time limit.

II. The sections or parts of the music:

- 1. Introduction
- 2. Verse
- 3. Chorus
- 4. Instrumental
- 5. Bridge
- 6. Ending
- > You mark a change in the music with a line.
- > You start at the top of the page and work your way downward.
- > You mark a break in the music with a line before and after the break.
- A good place to change from one formation to another is when a change of music occurs.
